Seq, .Executive Order No. 107 ("EO 107"), guidance issued by the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs ("DCA"), and newly signed A3850/S2294, P.L.2020, c11, this is to advise that the Board of Directors for the Atlantic City Municipal Utilities Authority, 401 N. Virginia Ave., Atlantic City, New Jersey, will hold Public Hearings on Tuesday, November 24, 2020, and on Thursday, December 3, 2020 at 10:00 AM to discuss the MUA's 2021 Budget, and Changes to the Rules, Rates, & Regulations by way of Office Conference Phone consistent with Executive Order 103 signed by the Governor Murphy on March 9, 2020 in an abundance of caution and to help prevent the spread of COVID-19.
