SEALED BIDS for furnishing all labor, tools, equipment of every description, all materials and supplies except those supplied by the Atlantic City Municipal Utilities Authority and furnishing whatever else is necessary for PROVIDING JANITORIAL SERVICES AT THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT PUMPING STATION FACILITY, 1151 N. Main Street, Pleasantville, NJ, and such related work as is specifically described in and in strict accordance with specifications for said work adopted by the Board of Directors of the Atlantic City Municipal Utilities Authority on April 21, 2021, will be received when called for by the Purchasing Board of said Authority at a meeting to be held in the Authority Conference Room, 401 N.
