SEALED BIDS or proposals for the Furnishing and Delivering of ZETA LYTE 1A ANIONIC POLYMER, suitable for the treatment of potable water, to the Pumping Station of the Atlantic City Municipal Utilities Authority, 1151 N. Main Street, Pleasantville, NJ, will be received by the Purchasing Board at a meeting to be held in the Authority Conference Room, 401 N. Virginia Avenue, Atlantic City, NJ, at the hour of 11:00 a.m. prevailing time on Tuesday, May 11, 2021, at which time and place such sealed proposals will be publicly opened and read.

Each proposal must be accompanied by a certified or cashiers check, drawn upon a national or state bank or trust company, payable to the Atlantic City Municipal Utilities Authority, in the amount of not less than TEN PERCENTUM (10%) of the total bid; or a bid bond for the same amount, but in no case in excess of \$20,000.00.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a surety bond of a company authorized to do business in the State of New Jersey in a sum equal to ONE HUNDRED PERCENTUM (100%) of the contract price.
