

EMERGENCY WATER SHUTDOWN

THE ATLANTIC CITY MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY HAS EXPERIENCED A WATER MAIN BREAK AT THE INTERSECTION OF WEST RIVERSIDE DRIVE AND GRAMMERCY AVENUE. THIS BREAK BEGAN AT APPROXIMATELY 3:00 P.M. THIS EVENING. WATER SERVICE CUSTOMERS ARE ASKED TO CONSERVE WATER AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE DURING THE TIME THAT THIS BREAK IS BEING ISOLATED.

THE AUTHORITY ANTICIPATES THAT THIS SHUTDOWN WILL EXIST THROUGHOUT THE EVENING OF APRIL 6, 2021. THE RESTORATION OF SERVICE OF THIS MAIN WILL RESULT IN RUSTY OR DISCOLORED WATER IN VARIOUS LOCATIONS IN THE AUTHORITY WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM. RESIDENTS ARE FURTHER ADVISED THAT THEY SHOULD AVOID THE INTERSECTION OF WEST RIVERSIDE DRIVE AND GRAMMERCY AVENUE, AND FIND AN ALTERNATE ROUTE TO GET ACROSS TOWN.
