WHEREAS, in 2022, due to USIC Locating Services LLC continuing to exceed the threshold amount of Seventeen Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars (\$17,500.00), the ACMUA attempted to find companies to solicit for Locating and Marking Services, but none of the companies showed interest.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of the Atlantic City Municipal Utilities Authority (the ACMUA) that the agreement with USIC Locating Services, LLC be amended to an amount not to exceed \$60,000.00 a year, until the ending of their agreement in June 2023.
