**WHEREAS**, the Deputy Executive Director of Operations and the Manager of the Water Treatment Plant conducted interviews of the eligible candidates for the position and determined Mr. Aires to be the most qualified candidate for the position; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Aires has accepted an offer by the Executive Director to fill the position of Assistant Manager of Maintenance at the Water Treatment Plant at a starting salary of \$75,000.00 with eligible increases of \$5,000.00 per license upon attainment of pertinent water licenses offered through the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, for a maximum salary of \$85,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Authority owns and maintains a residential property on the site of the Water Treatment Plant and said property will be restored and brought back into use as a component of the security measures at the Plant, with the occupant having responsibility to respond to emergent issues at the Plant; and

WHEREAS, although not required for appointment to the position, Mr. Aires has expressed an interest in residing at the aforementioned property and assuming the attendant duties, rights and responsibilities therewith, all to be laid out in greater detail and terms by a separate Use and Occupancy License Agreement prepared by the Board Attorney.
