## ACMUA Response to EPA Press Statement

ATLANTIC CITY, NJ – The Atlantic City Municipal Utilities Authority (ACMUA) acknowledges the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency’s (EPA) press release regarding an administrative order related to the Lead and Copper Rule.

The matters referenced by EPA involve sampling protocols, documentation, and reporting practices. No exceedances of lead action levels were identified, and there have been no water quality violations and no risk to public health associated with this review.

The EPA review is part of an administrative oversight process that began with a routine, randomly selected inspection in 2022 and resulted in an administrative order in 2023. Since early 2024, ACMUA has implemented organizational, administrative, and operational improvements to strengthen compliance management and regulatory coordination. The 2025 EPA review reflects this progress and resulted in a more limited administrative order.

ACMUA will continue to work cooperatively with the EPA and the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection to complete all remaining requirements under the administrative order.
